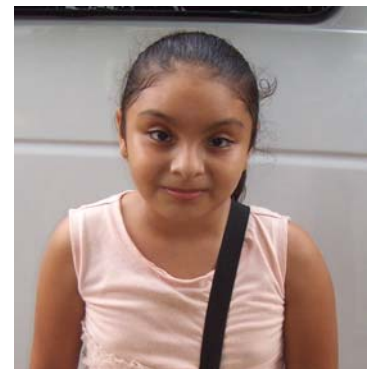
## MEET OUR KIDS
